





The purpose of the OH-SS Webinar Series is to commemorate and celebrate One Health Day by featuring inspirational speakers *to address the role of social science research and approaches in One Health strategies.*

OH-SS Webinar Series: Messages

- Key messages:
- OH-SS NOT a new discipline – not looking to create new silos
 - Must be ideology/tool to achieve desired results
 - Stressing synergy
 - OH beyond zoonosis

Honing the key messages

- Who is the target?
- Value chain of research and practice
- Primary source of information is community – key for research
- Explain how others can contribute/participate
- Policymakers – drive action, need to understand importance of collaboration
- System thinking for integrating surveillance system
- Data!
- Need buy-in – upstream and downstream users
- Need information flow e.g., continued surveillance from users at various levels
- Social aspects of communicating data
- Trainings? E.g., Florida OH concentration - field and lab (Greg Grey)
 - No focus on environments, animals in medical training
 - What are knowledge sets needed to be effective
- Qualitative and quantitative methods – social behavioral sciences
- Letters good way to reach across disciplines –
- Conferences – tools that can assist (e.g., satellite data)
