WHAT IS RABIES

RABIES IS A DEADLY DISEASE. PEOPLE GET RABIES BY COMING INTO CONTACT WITH A MAMMAL LIKE A BAT THAT IS INFECTED WITH THE RABIES VIRUS.



- DO NOT TOUCH WILDLIFE, INCLUDING BATS
- MAKE SURE YOUR PETS HAVE THEIR RABIES VACCINE UP-TO-DATE

WHAT TO DO IF YOU COME INTO CONTACT WITH A BAT:

- WASH ANY BITES OR SCRATCHES WITH SOAP AND WATER
- SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION
 IMMEDIATELY
