2. Description and Scope of One Health Activities

A transdisciplinary graduate school seeking integrated interventions to attain optimal health for humans, animals, plants and the environment. The graduate school is hosted in Bonn (Germany), at the Center for Development Research (ZEF) in cooperation with

- other institutions of the University of Bonn (Department of Geography; Institute for Medical Microbiology, Immunology and Parasitology; Institute for Hygiene and Public Health with Section Global Health, GeoHealth Center and AMR/One Health; Faculty of Agriculture with Global Change and Systemic Risks)
- the University of Applied Science Bonn Rhein-Sieg (HBRS), and
- the United Nations University Institute for Environment and Human Security (UNU-EHS).

PhD students conduct research in four metropolitan regions: Ruhr Metropolis (Germany); Ahmedabad (India), Accra (Ghana), and São Paulo (Brazil).

The Forschungskolleg "One Health and Urban Transformation – recognizing risks, developing sustainable solutions" was launched in July 2016 and will investigate the various dimensions and transformations of the urban systems and their impact on human, animal and environmental health.

The research concept is based upon four interconnected dimensions:

- 1. Holistic One Health (integrative approaches to sustainable development)
- 2. Urban Transformations (comparison of the Ruhr Valley with three urban metropolitan areas)
- 3. Cross-Cutting Topics (food security, water, hygiene, public health, health systems, society)
- Integrated Work Packages (recognition, analysis and coping mechanisms of societal urban challenges)
