9. Brief History of Your Organization's One Health Involvement

One Health Working Group of TMC was established in the end of 2018 and pursuing national and international collaborations in one health approach, with the participation of multidisciplinary members from human health, animal health, food science and environmental health.

On November 21-23, 2019 the National One Health Symposium was organized in Ankara again, and there was the One Health Workshop on 23rd, the last day. It was important because some representatives of the World Health Organization (WHO) Turkish Office, WHO European Office, CDC, Ministry of Health, Turkish Association of Medical Doctors, Turkish Association of Veterinarians, Turkish Association of Pharmacists, Turkish Chamber of Food Engineers, Food Safety Society; Turkish Foundation for Combating Soil Erosion, Reforestation and Protection of Natural Habitats (TEMA) attended the symposium. The final report of the workshop is being worked on and will be extended to the attendees, stakeholders and all authorities when ready. An article about the symposium was published in the newspaper, titled "Is the treatment of the sick world "ONE Health?"

The most important point of symposium and workshop was so cheap (inexpensive) for all student participants, only 25 Turkish liras. We wanted to join us more young scientist.

Additionally, we gave a podcast about one health on TRT 1 Radyo.
